SECONDARY QUESTIONS	PRE ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS
Any heavy vaginal bleeding?	Lie on back, Elevate legs and feet. Place a towel between the legs. Save any passed clots/tissue.
Abdominal pain or cramping?	
Any complications with this pregnancy?	
Any recent trauma? (GLF, MVA, Etc.)	
How many times has patient been pregnant?	
How many live births?

COMPLICATIONS OF PREGNANCY

TREATMENT

Eclampsia - pregnancy seizure	Lay mother on her side, keep airway open
Miscarriage - Early pregnancy bleeding	Lie on back, Elevate legs and feet. Place a towel between the legs. Save any passed clots/tissue.
Vaginal Bleeding - Pregnancy Bleeding	Lie on back, Elevate legs and feet. Place a towel between the legs. Save any passed clots/tissue.

- Miscarriage is present in up to 20% of recognized pregnancies. Primary focus is to provide psychological support to the patient and family.
